- All of Sarawak Energy's hydropower dams are designed and constructed following stringent guidelines by International Commission on Large Dams (ICOLD) to ensure the integrity and safety of our hydroelectric projects.
- Independent Reviews are conducted during construction, before impoundment and periodically during operations, practiced since the Batang Ai HEP was constructed in 1985.



- As a member of the International Hydropower Association (IHA), Sarawak Energy formally embeds the IHA's
 Hydropower Sustainability Assessment Protocol (HSAP) in its project development and operations.
- With the voluntary adoption of the HSAP guiding the responsible development of our hydropower portfolio, Sarawak
 Energy continues to subscribe to the sustainability agenda of maximising the benefits while minimising the social and
 environmental impacts of our projects.



- Sarawak Energy is the first corporation in Malaysia to commit to the "Business Ambition for 1.5°Celsius" under United Nations Global Compact.
- We are working towards voluntary climate-related financial disclosures guided by the Task Force on Climate-Related Financial Disclosures (TCFD) for better access to data in managing climate-related risks.
